

**RULES AND REGULATIONS  
MANSFIELD CEMETERY  
MANSFIELD, TEXAS 76063**

The following rules and regulations, as adopted by the Mansfield Cemetery Association (the Association), shall apply to all burial spaces in the Mansfield Cemetery:

1. FOR THE SAFETY OF OUR MAINTENANCE CREW, NO GLASS OR CERAMIC CONTAINERS ARE ALLOWED. ALL BREAKABLE ITEMS WILL BE DISCARDED.
2. For maintenance and mowing purposes, fences, curbs, bricks or rocks are NOT ALLOWED.
3. Only two flower arrangements per burial space are allowed, with the exception of Christmas, Easter, Mother's/Father's Day and decedent's birthday. Excessive items, on any burial space will be discarded.
4. Each burial space is four feet (4') X nine feet (9'). The monument/headstone and one bench must be located within this area.
5. No trees or shrubs are to be planted without prior approval by the Cemetery Association.
6. Concrete grave liners are required for all interments.
7. Inurnment of cremation remains require notice to the association and a monument within the burial space.
8. The association is not responsible for damage to any monument and strongly opposes upright monuments. Our soil will not withstand the weight and the proximity to other burial spaces puts them at risk of damage by heavy equipment. Levelling of sunken monuments is the sole responsibility of the decedent's family.

In the state of Texas, when you purchase a cemetery plot, you receive the "right of sepulture," which is your exclusive right to have your remains buried in a particular location. This deed does not convey real estate.

1. No change in ownership shall be effective unless and until the transfer has been registered upon the records of the Association and requisite transfer fee has been paid.
2. No one other than the owner of the burial plot shall be interred, entombed or inurned in such space unless and until the owner or the owner's legally appointed designee shall have notified the Association of such proposed interment, entombment or inurnment.
